## WHAT TO LOOK OUT FOR IN NOVENA AND TANGLIN!

Novena and Tanglin are well established housing areas located at the fringe of the city centre. Residents can look forward to more leisure and recreational spaces within the Singapore Botanic Gardens and the Whampoa estate, as well as the completion of new facilities at Health City Novena. Both areas will enjoy better connectivity with the completion of the Thomson-East Coast Line (TEL) by 2024. ## HOW OUR TOWNS ARE PLANNED

Our towns are planned to be liveable and self-sufficient, with easily accessible shops, health care, schools, community facilities and parks. Commercial nodes, industrial estates and business parks within or nearby the town, also help to provide nearer job opportunities for residents. The detailed planning and implementation of plans for each town is a joint effort of many government agencies.



## SINGAPORE BOTANIC GARDENS' GALLOP EXTENSION

The Gallop extension of the Tyersall-Gallop Core, an 8 hectare addition to the Singapore Botanic Gardens, will be completed by 2019. Visitors to the gardens will be able to explore and appreciate native forest ecology in one location, furthering the Gardens' mission of connecting people with plants.

## IMPROVED CONNECTIVITY

The North-South Corridor and new park connectors along Sungei Whampoa and Adam Road will enhance transport and recreational connectivity for residents and visitors alike.

## WHAMPOA PARK

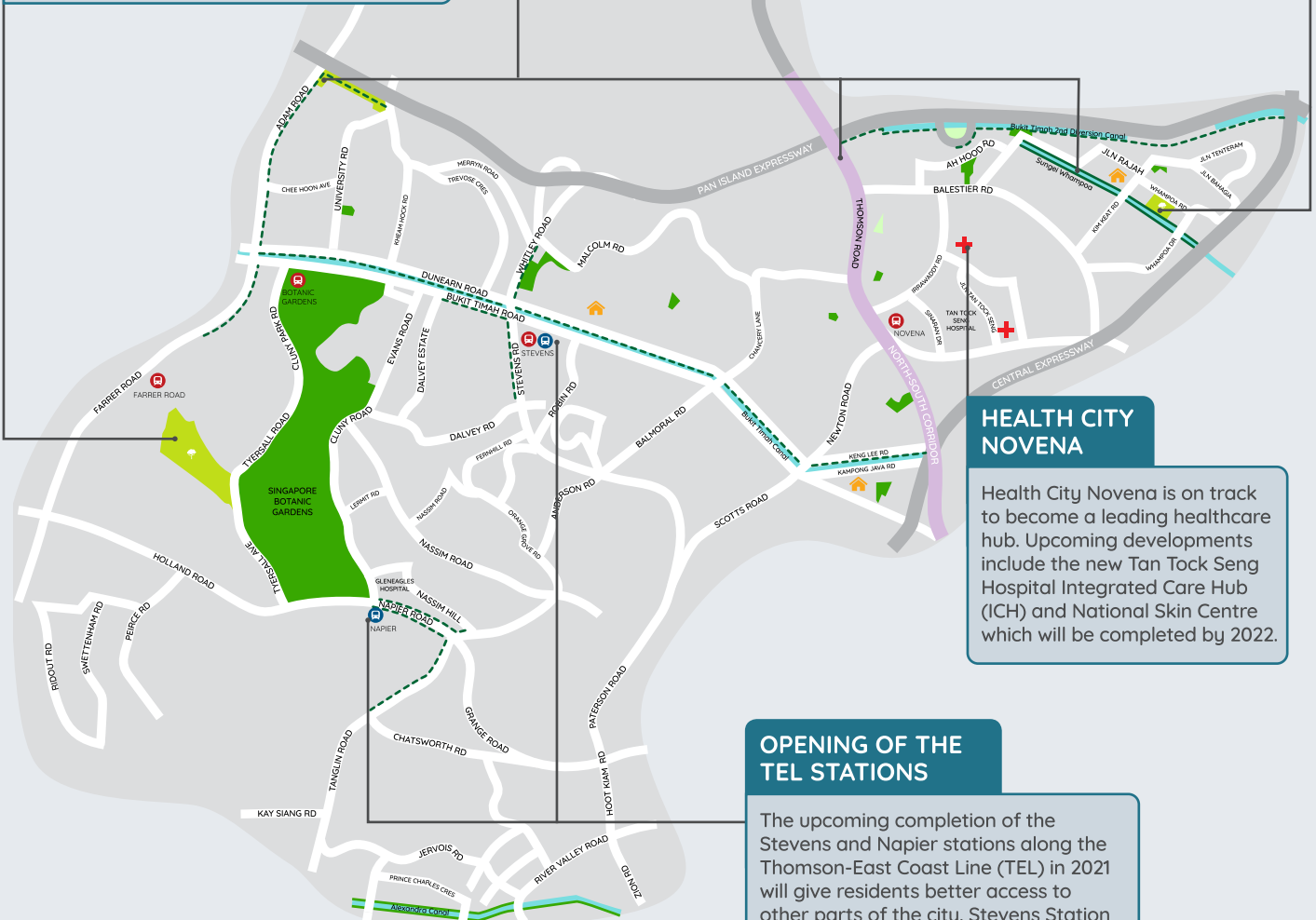
A new park at Whampoa Road will add greenery and recreation spaces for residents in the near future.

## HEALTH CITY NOVENA

Health City Novena is on track to become a leading healthcare hub. Upcoming developments include the new Tan Tock Seng Hospital Integrated Care Hub (ICH) and National Skin Centre which will be completed by 2022.

## OPENING OF THE TEL STATIONS

The upcoming completion of the Stevens and Napier stations along the Thomson-East Coast Line (TEL) in 2021 will give residents better access to other parts of the city. Stevens Station will also serve as an interchange with the Downtown Line (DTL).
